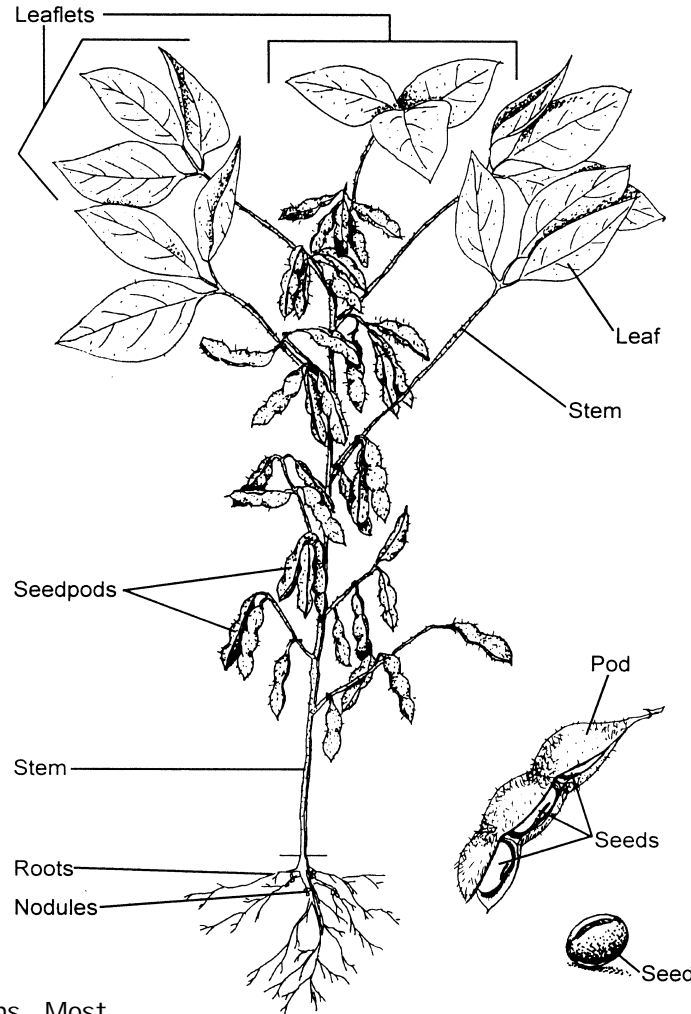

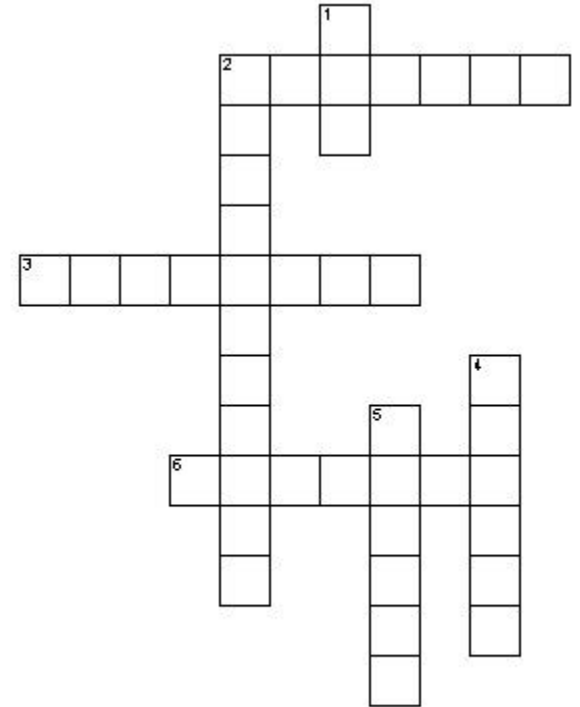
Did You Know?

- * Soybeans were first grown in China over 5,000 years ago.
- * In 2002, Canadian farmers produced over 2 million tonnes of soybeans. Most of these soybeans were used in animal feed and vegetable oil.
- * Although best known for building cars, Henry Ford was also a big believer in the potential of soybeans. Ford Company chemists created a variety of interior car parts made from soy-based plastic - even a suit made from soy fibre that Ford actually wore.
- * During the U.S. Civil War, soldiers used soybeans to brew soy "coffee" when real coffee was scarce.
- * In 2002, John Deere began using a soy-based plastic to manufacture the body panels on its complete line of combines.
- * Soybeans are a source of lecithin. Lecithin is used to keep the chocolate and cocoa butter in a candy bar from separating.
